

### Regulation under the Trading Hours Ordinance 1926-1931.

I, VICTOR CHARLES THOMPSON, a Member of the Federal Executive Council, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Trading Hours Ordinance* 1926-1931, hereby make the following Regulation.

#### AMENDMENT OF THE TRADING HOURS REGULATIONS.

Amendment of  
Schedule.

The Schedule to the Trading Hours Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from Form 1 the words "Minister of State for Home Affairs (*or* Delegate of the Minister of State for Home Affairs, *as the case may be.*)", and inserting in their stead the words "(Signature of Minister or Delegate of Minister.)"; and
- (b) by omitting from Form 2 the words "Federal Capital Territory Branch, Department of Home Affairs," and inserting in their stead the words "Secretary, Department of the Interior,".
