Commencement

1. These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Regulations

2. In these Regulations, “Principal Regulations” means the Electoral Regulations.

Insertion

3. After Part II of the Principal Regulations the following Part is inserted:

“PART IIA—BALLOT PAPERS**Declaration ballot papers**

“5A. The heading to be printed or endorsed on a ballot paper to be used for declaration voting shall be the heading to a ballot paper set out in Schedule 1 to the Act modified by inserting **Declaration** above **Ballot paper**.”.
