1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Legislative Assembly Precincts* Regulation 2016.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).


3 Premises included in Assembly precincts—Act, s 6 (2)

- (1) The required property is to be treated as part of the Assembly precincts for the Act.
- (2) In this section:

required property means that part of block 22, section 19, division of City, Canberra Central District that is 624m^2 of Level 1 (east) of the North Building as indicated in the shaded areas on the plan of premises in schedule 1.
