

NOXIOUS WEEDS.

No. 6 of 1922.^(a)

An Ordinance to amend the Noxious Weeds Ordinance 1921.^(b)

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Noxious Weeds Ordinance* 1922.

(2.) The *Noxious Weeds Ordinance* 1921 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be referred to as the *Noxious Weeds Ordinance* 1921–1922.

Minister may give notice to destroy noxious weeds.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by adding at the end of sub-section (1) thereof the words “and to keep the land free from noxious weeds for any specified period thereafter”, and

(b) by inserting in sub-section (3), after the words “contained therein”, the words “in regard to the noxious weeds then growing on the land, and during the period specified in the notice he shall keep the land free from noxious weeds”.

Form of notice to destroy noxious weeds.

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the following Schedule:—

TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

NOXIOUS WEEDS ORDINANCE 1921.

To _____ owner of land (area) _____ situate at _____

You are hereby required to (state action required) the (here set out weeds to be dealt with) growing upon your land specified above, and the half of the road abutting such land, within (here state time) and thereafter to keep your land free from such noxious weeds until (here state end of maintenance period). Failure to comply with the terms of this notice will render you liable to a fine not exceeding £20.
