THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 13 of 1927.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Church Lands Leases Ordinance 1924.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910*, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Church Lands Leases Ordinance 1927*. Short title and citation.

(2.) *The Church Lands Leases Ordinance 1924* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Church Lands Leases Ordinance 1924–1927*.

2. Section two of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead :—

“ 2.—This Ordinance shall apply within the same area as the *City Area Leases Ordinance 1924–1926*.” Application of Ordinance.

3. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words “ a non-secular school ” and inserting in their stead the words “ a school where religious instruction only is given.” Meaning of “ church purposes.”
