No. 14 of 1930.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Ordinance 1927.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, pursuant to the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1930* as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1930*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Ordinance 1927*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1927-1930*.

2. Section five of the *Police Ordinance 1927* is amended by inserting after the words "officers of police" the words ", and such clerical officers in connexion with the police force,". Appointment of Police.

3. Section twenty of the *Police Ordinance 1927* is amended by omitting the figures "1927" and inserting in their stead the figures "1930". Police may apprehend any offender whose name and residence is unknown.

4. Section twenty-one of the *Police Ordinance 1927* is amended by omitting the figures "1927" and inserting in their stead the figures "1930". Apprehension of known offenders.
