AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Church Lands Leases Ordinance 1924-1927.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Church Lands Leases Ordinance* 1930. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Church Lands Leases Ordinance* 1924-1927 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Church Lands Leases Ordinance* 1924-1930.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Minister" and inserting in its stead the word "Commission". Power to grant leases.

3.—(1.) Section six of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "at the rate of One pound per centum per annum upon the unimproved value of the land as determined by the Minister, and shall not be subject to reappraisalment" and inserting in their stead the words "One shilling per annum, payable if and when demanded by the Commission". Rental of leases.

(2.) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-sixth day of March, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.

4. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Minister" and inserting in its stead the word "Commission". Conditions of leases.

5. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words ", residence for clergy or a school where religious instruction only is given" and inserting in their stead the following proviso:—

"Provided that nothing in this section shall prevent the erection, on a site granted for a church, of a residence for clergy or a school where religious instruction only is given."
