THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 9 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Administration and Probate Ordinance
1929-1932.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act*, 1910-1931, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1933. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1932 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1933.

2. Section fifty-eight A of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Passing and allowance of accounts of executors, &c.

(a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the word “and” (last occurring); and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—

“and (c) in and about the investment of moneys by the Curator under section one hundred and four of this Ordinance.”

3. Section one hundred and four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the word “Court” (first occurring), the words “or a Justice”. Curator to invest moneys after expiration of six months.
