# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 24 of 1934.

## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Building and Services Ordinance*  
1924-1928.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1933, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Building and Services Ordinance* 1934. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Building and Services Ordinance* 1924-1928 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Building and Services Ordinance* 1924-1934.

2. Section one A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in the definition of "Services" after the word "electricity" the words "the hiring and supply of electrical stoves and other electrical heating appliances, the provision of aerial masts and fittings in connection with wireless receivers". Definition.
