No. 15 of 1936. AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Real Property Ordinance 1925-1934

DE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, pursuant to the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Real Property short title and Ordinance 1936.
- (2.) The Real Property Ordinance 1925-1934 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Real Property Ordinance 1925-1936.
- 2. Section sixty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Registrar may inserting in sub-section (6.) the words "or, if the map or plan be deposited." deposited by the registered proprietor is not approved by the Surveyor-General and Chief Property Officer of the Department of the Interior or by an officer appointed by him in that behalf,".

paid on the registration of

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (c) of the proviso the word "or" (last occurring); and
 - adding at the end thereof the paragraph:-

"or (e) a transfer to a body formed for religious, educational or charitable purposes, of a Crown lease of land required by the lease to be used for any such purposes or for the promotion of religious, educational or charitable objects,".
