AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Leases (Special Purposes)
Ordinance 1925-1932.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1936*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925-1932* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Leases (Special Purposes) Ordinance 1925-1936*.

2. Section five A of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word “tenth” and inserting in its stead the word “twentieth”;
and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word “ten” and inserting in its stead the word “twenty”.
