**No. 3 of 1937.**

## AN ORDINANCE

### **To amend the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1929-1934.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1933, as follows:—

**1.**—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1937. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1934, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1937.

**2.** Section thirteen of the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1934 is amended by inserting in sub-section (4.), after the word "Territory", the words "or in the State of New South Wales," Probates to Trustee Company.
