No. 19 of 1938.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1937.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1937* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1938*.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the definition of “Trainee apprentice” and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

“‘Trainee apprentice’ means a person who is employed in an apprenticeship trade without indentures or other written contract for the purpose of learning to be a skilled journeyman.”

3. Section nineteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word “minor” (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word “person”. Persons not to be employed in apprenticeship trades except in pursuance of Ordinance
