No. 40 of 1938.

AN ORDINANCE

Relating to Rabbit Destruction.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1938*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919* as amended by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1938*, the *Seat of Government (Designation) Ordinances 1938* and by the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1937*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1938*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Definition. omitting the definition of "The Minister".

3. The First Schedule to the *Ordinances Revision Ordinance 1938* is amended by omitting from Part II. the words "*Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1937—Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1938*". Amendment of Ordinances Revision Ordinance 1938.
