AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 10 of 1939.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Police Offences Ordinance 1930-1937 as amended by the Police Offences Ordinance 1939.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Offences Ordinance (No. 2) 1939*. Short title and citation.

(2.) Sub-section (2.) of the *Police Offences Ordinance 1939* is repealed.

(3.) The *Police Offences Ordinance 1930-1937*, as amended by the *Police Offences Ordinance 1939*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(4.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Offences Ordinance 1930-1939*.

2. Section forty-seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Common assault.

“(2.) Any person convicted of an offence against this section shall remain liable to all civil proceedings in like manner as if he had not been so convicted.”
