AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937.

B^E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933, as follows:--

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Trespass on Short title Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1939.

(2.) The Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939.

2. Section four A of the Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Animals Ordinance 1932-1937 is amended by adding at the end thereof the on following sub-section :--

"(2.) For the purposes of this section the owner of an animal includes—

- (a; any person who has the care, custody or control of the animal; and
- (b) any person on whose premises the animal is kept or agisted.".
