AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1933*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1939*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1939*.

2. Section four A of the *Trespass on Commonwealth Lands Ordinance 1932-1937* is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Animals straying, &c., on Commonwealth lands.

“(2.) For the purposes of this section the owner of an animal includes—

(a) any person who has the care, custody or control of the animal; and

(b) any person on whose premises the animal is kept or agisted.”
