## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1936-1944.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1946*.\* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1936-1944*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1936-1946*.

2. After section five F of the *Careless Use of Fire Ordinance 1936-1944* the following section is inserted:—

“5FA.—(1.) The Minister may, in respect of each member of the Council, appoint a person to be the deputy of that member. Deputies of members of Council.

“(2.) Any person so appointed shall, in the event of the absence (through illness or otherwise) of the member of whom he is the deputy, have all the powers of that member during his absence.”
