

# AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 3 of 1946.

## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Racecourses Ordinance 1935-1945  
and for other purposes.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Racecourses Ordinance 1946*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Racecourses Ordinance 1935-1945* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Racecourses Ordinance 1935-1946*.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of the definition of "Race-meeting" the words "or foot-racing". Definitions.

3. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the third column the words and figures "Sections 3 to 5 (inclusive)" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "Sections 2 to 5 (inclusive)". The Schedule.

4. Section two of the *Gaming and Betting Act 1906* of the State of New South Wales in its application to the Australian Capital Territory is amended by adding at the end of the definition of "Race-meeting" the words "or foot-racing". Amendment of Gaming and Betting Act 1906.
