AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1938.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1950*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1948*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1950*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the fourth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.^{Commencement.}

3. Section forty-three of the *Apprenticeship Ordinance 1936-1938* is amended—^{Wages rates.}

(a) by inserting after the word “apprentice” the words “or trainee apprentice”; and

(b) by omitting the proviso thereto.
