

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

No. 10 of 1955.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Leases Ordinance 1918-1937.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Leases Ordinance 1955*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Leases Ordinance 1918-1937*† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Leases Ordinance 1918-1955*.

2. Section three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words “, not exceeding twenty-five years,”. Grant of leases.

3. Section three AB of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (3.) all the words after the words “approved by the Minister”. Reduction of rent and relief from conditions.

4. Section three A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words “signed by the Secretary to the Department of the Interior,”. Survey fees.
