AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938*.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Stat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1947*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Ordinance 1955*.^{* Short title and citation.}

(2.) The *Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1955*.

2. Section five of the *Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938* is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the definition of "Director-General".^{Definitions.}
