To amend the *Education Ordinance 1937-1952*.

EDUCATION ORDINANCE 1956.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1956*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Education Ordinance 1937-1952*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1937-1956*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the third day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six. Commencement.

3. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the proviso to paragraph (d) the words "one penny" and inserting in their stead the word "Threepence". Defence in prosecutions under sections 8 and 9.

4. Section thirty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "one penny" and inserting in their stead the word "Threepence". Admission to school.
