To amend the *Police Ordinance 1927-1955*.

POLICE ORDINANCE 1956.*

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1956*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Police Ordinance 1927-1955*† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Ordinance 1927-1956*.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the definition of "Commissioner" the word "Chief". Definitions.

3. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) the word "Chief". Establishment of Police Force.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Chief". Schedule.

5. Where, in any Ordinance or in any regulations or other instrument, made under an Ordinance, a reference is made to the Chief Officer of Police or to the Chief Commissioner of Police that reference shall be read as a reference to the Commissioner of Police. References in other Ordinances.
