

RETURNED SERVICEMEN'S BADGES.

No. 10 of 1960.

An Ordinance to prohibit the Unauthorized Wearing of Membership Badges issued by the Returned Sailors', Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Returned Servicemen's Badges Ordinance 1960*.^{*} Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, "the League" means the Returned Sailors' Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia. Definition.

3.—(1.) A person shall not wear a badge issued by the League unless he is the person to whom the badge was issued. Unauthorized wearing of R.S.L. badgc.

(2.) A person to whom a badge has been issued by the League shall not wear the badge if that person is not entitled, under the Rules of the League, to wear the badge.

Penalty: Twenty-five pounds.
