An Act to prohibit the Unauthorized Wearing of Membership Badges issued by the Returned Sailors', Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the *Returned Servicemen's Badges Act 1960*.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Interpretation**

2. In this Act, "the League" means the Returned Sailors' Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia.

#### **Unauthorised wearing of R.S.L. badge**

3. (1) A person shall not wear a badge issued by the League unless he is the person to whom the badge was issued.

(2) A person to whom a badge has been issued by the League shall not wear the badge if that person is not entitled, under the Rules of the League, to wear the badge.

Penalty: Fifty dollars.

#### NOTE

1. The *Returned Servicemen's Badges Act 1960* as shown in this reprint comprises Act No. 10, 1960 amended as indicated in the Tables below.

Citation of Laws—The *Self-Government (Citation of Laws) Act 1989* (No. 21, 1989) altered the citation of most Ordinances so that after Self-Government day they are to be cited as Acts. That Act also affects references in ACT laws to Commonwealth Acts.
