

PUBLIC BATHS AND PUBLIC BATHING.

No. 6 of 1961.

An Ordinance to amend the *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance* 1956-1959.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance* 1961.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance* 1956-1959† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Baths and Public Bathing Ordinance* 1956-1961.

2. After section fourteen of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

“14A. A person shall not, without the approval of the Minister or of a person authorized by the Minister to give approvals under this section, in any public baths, engage for reward in teaching a person to swim or in coaching or instructing a person in swimming.”. Swimming coaches and instructors.

3. Section seventeen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (e), after the word “earthenware”, the words “, or any article of glass, earthenware or tin.”. Offences in relation to public baths.

4. Section thirty-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in paragraph (a), after the word “earthenware”, the words “, or any article of glass, earthenware or tin.”. Glass, &c., in public places.
