

POLICE

No. 2 of 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the *Police Ordinance*
1927-1960.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police Ordinance* 1964.* Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Police Ordinance* 1927-1960,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Police Ordinance* 1927-1964.

2. Section thirteen of the *Police Ordinance* 1927-1960 is amended by inserting after sub-section (1.) the following sub-section:— Personating
members of
police force
an offence.

“ (1A.) A person who, not being a member of the police force of a State or of a Territory of the Commonwealth other than the Australian Capital Territory—

(a) personates or passes himself off as a member of such a police force; or

(b) wears or displays any uniform or badge of a member of such a police force, any colourable imitation of such a uniform or badge, or any uniform or badge so closely resembling such a uniform or badge as to be likely to deceive,

shall be guilty of an offence.”
