

LAW REFORM (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS)

No. 14 of 1965

An Ordinance to amend the *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance 1955.*

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance 1965.* Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance 1955*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance 1955-1965.*

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (b) of sub-section (1.) the words “or within such further period as the Supreme Court, on an application made, either before or after the expiration of that period, allows”. Conditions
precedent to
survival of
causes of action.

3.—(1.) Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:— Saving of
other rights.

“(2.) The rights conferred by this Part for the benefit of the estates of deceased persons and the obligations continued or created under or by virtue of this Part against the estates of deceased persons are in addition to, and not in derogation of, any rights conferred or obligations created by or under Part IVA. of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1955*, or that Ordinance as amended from time to time.”.

(2.) The amendment made by the last preceding sub-section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirty-first day of March, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
