

AUSTRALIAN-AMERICAN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

An Ordinance relating to the Australian-American Educational Foundation.

- Short title.** 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Australian-American Educational Foundation Ordinance 1966*.*
- Repeal.** 2. The *United States Educational Foundation in Australia Ordinance 1950* is repealed.
- Administration.** 3. This Ordinance shall be administered by the Attorney-General.
- Definitions.** 4. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears—
 “the Agreement” means the agreement dated the twenty-eighth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, made between the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the United States of America for the financing of certain educational and cultural exchange programmes;
 “the former Foundation” means the Foundation referred to in the *United States Educational Foundation in Australia Ordinance 1950*;
 “the Foundation” means the Australian-American Educational Foundation established under the Agreement.
- Incorporation of Foundation.** 5.—(1.) For the purpose of facilitating the operations of the Foundation under the Agreement, the Foundation is by this Ordinance established as a body corporate with perpetual succession under the name of “Australian-American Educational Foundation”.
- (2.) The Foundation—
 (a) shall have a common seal;
 (b) is capable of acquiring (whether as grantee or transferee), holding and disposing of or otherwise dealing with real and personal property;

(c) may enter into contracts; and

(d) may sue and be sued, whether the cause of action arose before or arises after the commencement of this Ordinance.

(3.) All courts, judges and persons acting judicially shall take judicial notice of the common seal of the Foundation affixed to a document and shall presume that it was duly affixed.

6. The power to dispose of real and personal property conferred on the Foundation by the last preceding section shall be deemed to include a power to dispose of land registered under the *Real Property Ordinance* 1925-1963 in the name of the former Foundation as if the Foundation were the registered proprietor of the land.

7. A notice, process or other document may, for the purposes of any law of the Territory, be served upon or given to the Foundation—

Service of documents.

- (a) by leaving it at the office of the Foundation at Canberra with some person apparently in the service of the Foundation; or
 - (b) by sending it by registered post to the Foundation at that office.
