About this republication

The republished law

This is a republication of the *Australian-American Educational Foundation Act 1966* effective from 30 November 1996 to 11 September 2001.

Kinds of republications

Editorial changes

The *Legislation (Republication) Act 1996*, part 3, division 2 authorised the Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial amendments and other changes of a formal nature when preparing a law for republication. Editorial changes do not change the effect of the law, but have effect as if they had been made by an Act commencing on the republication date (see *Legislation (Republication) Act 1996*, s 14 and s 16). The changes are made if the Parliamentary Counsel considers they are desirable to bring the law into line, or more closely into line, with current legislative drafting practice.

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An Act relating to the Australian-American Educational Foundation

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Australian-American Educational Foundation Act 1966*.¹

Repeal

2. The *United States Educational Foundation in Australia Ordinance 1950* is repealed.

Interpretation

4. In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

“the Agreement” means the agreement dated 28 August 1964, made between the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the United States of America for the financing of certain educational and cultural exchange programmes;

“the former Foundation” means the Foundation referred to in the *United States Educational Foundation in Australia Ordinance 1950*;

“the Foundation” means the Australian-American Educational Foundation established under the Agreement.

Incorporation of Foundation

5. (1) For the purpose of facilitating the operations of the Foundation under the Agreement, the Foundation is by this Act established as a body corporate with perpetual succession under the name of “Australian-American Educational Foundation”.

(2) The Foundation—

- (a) shall have a common seal;
- (b) is capable of acquiring (whether as grantee or transferee), holding and disposing of or otherwise dealing with real and personal property;
- (c) may enter into contracts; and
- (d) may sue and be sued, whether the cause of action arose before or arises after the commencement of this Act.

(3) All courts, judges and persons acting judicially shall take judicial notice of the common seal of the Foundation affixed to a document and shall presume that it was duly affixed.

Power to dispose of land in the name of former Foundation

6. The power to dispose of real and personal property conferred on the Foundation by the last preceding section shall be deemed to include a power to dispose of land registered under the *Land Titles Act 1925* in the name of the former Foundation as if the Foundation were the registered proprietor of the land.

Service of documents

7. A notice, process or other document may, for the purposes of any law of the Territory, be served upon or given to the Foundation—

- (a) by leaving it at the office of the Foundation at Canberra with some person apparently in the service of the Foundation; or
 - (b) by sending it by registered post to the Foundation at that office.

NOTES

1. The *Australian-American Educational Foundation Act 1966* as shown in this reprint comprises Act No. 16, 1966 amended as indicated in the Tables below.

Citation of Laws—The *Self-Government (Citation of Laws) Act 1989* (No. 21, 1989) altered the citation of most Ordinances so that after Self-Government day they are to cited as Acts. That Act also affects references in ACT laws to Commonwealth Acts.

2. The *Legislation (Republication) Act 1996* (No. 51, 1996) authorises the Parliamentary Counsel in preparing a law for republication, to make certain editorial and other formal amendments in accordance with current legislative drafting practice. Those amendments make no change in the law. Amendments made pursuant to that Act do not appear in the Table of Amendments but details may be obtained on request from the Parliamentary Counsel's Office.
