To amend the *Education Ordinance 1937-1966*.*

EDUCATION ORDINANCE 1971.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1971*.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Education Ordinance 1937-1966*,† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Education Ordinance 1937-1971*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the first day of November, 1971. Commencement.

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the proviso to paragraph (d) the words "Two cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Five cents". Defence in prosecutions under sections 8 and 9.

4. Section 34 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "Two cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Five cents". Admission to school.
