GUN LICENCE ORDINANCE 1971

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Gun Licence Ordinance 1971*.\*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Gun Licence Ordinance 1937-1970*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Gun Licence Ordinance 1937-1971*.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting in sub-section (7.), after the word “ Commonwealth ”, the words “ or an officer of a public authority ”;
- (b) by omitting from that sub-section the word “ department ” and inserting in its stead the words “ Department or authority ”;
- (c) by inserting in that sub-section, after the word “ premises ”, the words “ or on the premises of the authority ”;
- (d) by inserting in that sub-section, after the words “ business of the Department ”, the words “ or the authority ”; and
- (e) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—
  - “ (8.) In the last preceding sub-section—
  - ‘ officer ’ includes an employee;
  - ‘ public authority ’ means an authority established by or under an Act or an Ordinance.”.

Use, carriage or possession of gun or pistol.
