To amend the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1968*.

### THEATRES AND PUBLIC HALLS ORDINANCE 1971

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1971*.<sup>\*</sup>

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1968*,<sup>†</sup> as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1971*.

2. Section 27 of the *Theatres and Public Halls Ordinance 1928-1968* is amended—

Public  
entertainments  
and meetings  
not to be held  
on certain days.

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "any Sunday"; and
- (b) by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:—

"(2.) The last preceding sub-section does not apply to any public entertainment or public meeting the holding of which is authorized in writing by the Minister."
