TRADING HOURS ORDINANCE 1971

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1971*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962-1968*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962-1971*.

2. Section 7 of the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962-1968* is amended by inserting after sub-section (2.) the following sub-section:— Goods other than exempt goods and goods sold by auction.

“(2A.) Notwithstanding the last preceding sub-section, the sale of souvenirs, art works, post cards and stationery on a Sunday is not prohibited.”.
