### FILM CLASSIFICATION ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Film Classification Ordinance 1972*.\*

Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Film Classification Ordinance 1971*,<sup>†</sup> as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Film Classification Ordinance 1971-1972*.

2. Section 8 of the *Film Classification Ordinance 1971* is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "and each person who receives or is entitled to receive any of the proceeds from the exhibition of the film are each guilty of an offence against this Ordinance and are liable" and inserting in their stead the words "is guilty of an offence against this Ordinance and is liable".
