TRADING HOURS ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1972*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962-1971*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Trading Hours Ordinance 1962-1972*.

2. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (2A.). Goods other than exempt goods and goods sold by auction.

3. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end thereof the following item:— The Schedule.

“ 11. Souvenirs, post cards, stationery, art works and reproductions of art works.”.
