CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES ORDINANCE 1972

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1972*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1966*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1972*.

2. Section 14G of the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1966* Loan limit. is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-sections (2.), (3.), (4.) and (5.) the words “Eight hundred dollars” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “One thousand dollars”; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-sections (3.), (4.) and (5.) the words “Two thousand dollars” (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words “Four thousand dollars”.
