To amend the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1972*.

CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1973*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1972*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1973*.

2. Section 14B of the *Co-operative Societies Ordinance 1939-1972* is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) and substituting the following paragraph:— Second mortgage.

“(a) the prior mortgage is not in favour of the society, another registered building society, the Commissioner for Housing appointed in pursuance of the *Housing Ordinance 1928-1969* or the Director of Defence Service Homes appointed in pursuance of the *Defence Service Homes Act 1918-1973*.”.
