LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1973*.*

Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1972*,† as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1973*.

2. Section 7 of the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970-1972* is amended by omitting sub-sections (2) and (3) and substituting the following sub-sections:—

Barristers
and
Solicitors
Admission
Board.

“ (2) Subject to section 8, a member of the Admission Board other than the Judge holds office for the period that—

(a) commences on the date of the instrument of his appointment or, where the appointment is expressed to commence on some later date, on that later date; and

(b) ends on the next succeeding thirty-first day of December.

“ (3) A member of the Admission Board other than the Judge is eligible for reappointment.”
