MOTOR TRAFFIC ORDINANCE (No. 5) 1973

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 5) 1973*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1972*,[†] as amended by the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1973*,[‡] the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 2) 1973*,[§] the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 3) 1973* || and the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 4) 1973*,[¶] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Section 1 of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance (No. 4) 1973* is amended by omitting sub-section (4).

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1973*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 November 1973. Commencement.

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended as set out in Schedule 1. Amendments of Principal Ordinance.

4. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the Schedule set out in Schedule 2 substituted. First Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SCALE OF FEES PAYABLE FOR REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND LICENCES AND FOR EACH RENEWAL

1. (1) Registration or renewal of registration of any motor vehicle, being a motor car, motor lorry, motor tractor or public motor vehicle:—
- (a) motor car or public motor vehicle (other than a motor omnibus)—at the rate of 70 cents per half cwt. of its weight;
- (b) motor lorry—
- (i) of weight not exceeding 40 cwt.—at the rate of 70 cents per half cwt. of its weight;
- (ii) of weight exceeding 40 cwt. but not exceeding 80 cwt.—at the rate of 85 cents per half cwt. of its weight;
- (iii) of weight exceeding 80 cwt. but not exceeding 120 cwt.—at the rate of one dollar per half cwt. of its weight;
- (iv) of weight exceeding 120 cwt.—at the rate of one dollar per half cwt. of its weight;
- (c) motor omnibus—at the rate of one dollar per half cwt. of its weight;
- (d) motor tractor—
- (i) where the tractor is owned by a farmer and used solely for the carting of his own produce and not let out on hire 4.00
- (ii) in any other case 20.00
- (2) In the case of a motor lorry owned by a farmer and used solely for the carting of his own produce and not let out on hire, the rate shall be one-half of the rate which would, but for this sub-clause, be applicable to that motor lorry.
2. Registration or renewal of registration of motor cycle—
- (a) without side car 6.00
- (b) with side car 10.00
3. Registration or renewal of registration of any other motor vehicle 20.00
4. (a) Except where sub-clause 5 (a) applies, a licence or renewal of a licence to drive a motor vehicle, other than a motor vehicle referred to in sub-clause (b) of this clause—
- (i) for a period of one year 5.00
- (ii) for a period of two years 10.00
- (iii) for a period of three years 15.00
- (b) Except where sub-clause 5 (b) applies, a licence or renewal of a licence to drive a taxi, a private hire car or a motor omnibus plying for hire .. 5.00
- (c) Where a licence is in respect of a licensed goods motor vehicle or a motor vehicle licensed to carry workmen to and from their work, in addition .. 1.25

(b) Licence or renewal of a licence to drive a motor vehicle of the kind referred to in sub-clause 4 (b), where the applicant for the licence or the renewal is, at the time of the application, the holder of a licence referred to in sub-clause 4 (a)	1.00

(i) Motor omnibus—	
(a) where registered under this Ordinance as a motor omnibus ..	No fee
