ARCHITECTS ORDINANCE 1973

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Architects Ordinance 1973*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Architects Ordinance 1959-1971*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Architects Ordinance 1959-1973*.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words— Parts.

“Part IV.—The Conduct of Architectural Practice (Sections 28-30).”

and inserting in their stead the words—

“Part IV.—The Conduct of Architectural Practice (Sections 28-29).”

3. Section 30 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
