CORONERS ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Coroners Ordinance 1974*.^{*} Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Coroners Ordinance 1956-1973*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Coroners Ordinance 1956-1974*.
2. Section 33 of the *Coroners Ordinance 1956-1973* is amended— Coroner's findings.
 - (a) by omitting from sub-section (3) the words and figures "*Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1953*" and substituting the words and figures "*Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1974*";
 - (b) by omitting from sub-section (6) the words and figures "*Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1953*" and substituting the words and figures "*Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1974*"; and
 - (c) by omitting from sub-section (7) the words and figures "*Part VI. of the Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1953*" and substituting the words and figures "*Parts VI and XIII A of the Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930-1974*".
