To amend the *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965-1968*.

CANBERRA THEATRE TRUST ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1974*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965-1968*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965-1974*.

2. Section 19 of the *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965-1968* is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— Certain land to be off-street parking area.

“(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Ordinance, or sub-section 109 (6) of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1974*, the provisions of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1974*, other than sub-section 109 (6), apply to, and in relation to—

- (a) every carriageway in the Canberra Theatre Centre that is available for use by the public;
- (b) every area of land within the Canberra Theatre Centre that is available for use by the public for the parking of motor vehicles; and
- (c) every entrance to, or exit from, such a carriageway or area of land,

as if the carriageway, area of land, entrance or exit were an off-street parking area and a public place within the meaning of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1974*.”
