MILK AUTHORITY ORDINANCE 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1974*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971-1973*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971-1974*.

2. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“ 16. (1) Subject to sub-section (2), the functions of the Authority are, in accordance with but subject to this Ordinance, to regulate and control the supply, sale and distribution of milk in the Territory. Functions of Authority.

“ (2) For the purpose of sub-section (1), regulation of the sale of milk does not include regulation of the prices at which milk may be sold or the charges that may be made in connexion with the sale of milk.”

3. Sections 34A and 34B of the Principal Ordinance are repealed. Repeal.
