To amend the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1966*.

RABBIT DESTRUCTION ORDINANCE 1975

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1975*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1966*† is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1975*.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Repeal.

3. Section 34 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words and figures “, and nothing shall be done in contravention of the Noxious Microbes Act, No. 23, 1900, of the State of New South Wales”. Powers of Minister where owner or occupier makes default.

4. The Principal Ordinance is further amended as set out in the Schedule. Further amendments.
