**MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES ORDINANCE 1975** 

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Omnibus Services Short title and citation.

(2) The Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955-1974,<sup>†</sup> as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955-1975.

2. Section 4A of the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955- Section 1974 is amended—

Section signs and stopping places.

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (1) (a) the words "con-places, sisting of the word 'Section '" and substituting the words "bearing the word 'Section ', whether with or without any other words "; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (1) (b) the words "consisting of the words 'Bus stop' or 'Signal Bus'" and substituting the words "bearing the words 'Bus Stop' or 'Signal Bus', whether with or without any other words".
