To amend the *Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1975*.

WATER RATES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Water Rates (Amendment) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1975*[†] is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Water Rates Ordinance 1959-1976*.

2. Section 20B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "One dollar" and substituting the symbol and figure "\$5". Rates certificate where land unmetered or not connected to system of works.

3. Section 21 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Testing of meters.

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the words "Two dollars" and substituting the symbol and figures "\$10"; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (2) the words "the fee of Two dollars" and substituting the words "the fee paid for the purpose of sub-section (1)".

Notwithstanding the amendments of the Principal Ordinance made by this Ordinance, sections 20B and 21 of the Principal Ordinance as in force immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance continue to apply to, and in relation to, requests made for the purposes of those sections before the commencement of this Ordinance.
