AN ORDINANCE

To amend certain laws of the Territory in consequence of the making of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.

ORDINANCES REVISION (REMUNERATION) ORDINANCE
1976

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Ordinances Revision (Remuneration) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title.

2. Section 11 of the *Agents Ordinance 1968* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“ 11. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.” Fees and allowances.

3. Section 8 of the *Architects Ordinance 1959* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“ 8. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.” Fees and allowances.

4. (1) Section 13 of the *Building Ordinance 1972* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“ 13. The Review Committee is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.” Fees and allowances to members of Review Committee.

(2) Section 24 of the *Building Ordinance 1972* is amended by omitting sub-section (10) and substituting the following sub-section:—

“(10) The Standards Committee is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

5. Section 11 of the *Buildings (Design and Siting) Ordinance 1964* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“11. (1) The Committee is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.

“(2) The *Remuneration Ordinance 1976* applies to, and in relation to, the deputy of a member of the Committee as if the deputy were a member of the Committee.”.

6. Section 5 of the *Canberra Commercial Development Authority Ordinance 1974* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“5. The Authority is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

7. Section 10 of the *Canberra Retail Markets Ordinance 1971* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“10. The Trust is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

8. Section 10 of the *Canberra Showground Trust Ordinance 1976* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“10. The Trust is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

9. Section 13 of the *Canberra Theatre Trust Ordinance 1965* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“13. The Trust is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

10. Section 7 of the *Consumer Affairs Ordinance 1973* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“7. The Council is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

11. Section 9 of the *Liquor Ordinance 1975* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“9. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

12. Section 9 of the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

Fees and allowances.

“9. The Authority is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.

13. Section 9 of the *Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“9. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.” Fees and allowances.

14. Section 8 of the *Surveyors Ordinance 1967* is repealed and the following section substituted:—

“8. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.” Fees and allowances.
