To amend the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*.

LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance 1977*.^{*} Short title.
2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*.[†] Principal Ordinance.
3. Section 6L of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word and figures "1 July 1977" and substituting the word and figures "1 October 1977". Part 1b to expire on 1 October 1977.
4. Section 5 of the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1976* is repealed. Repeal.
5. On and after 1 October 1977, the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967* has effect in relation to the provisions of Part 1b of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, as if those provisions had been repealed on that day by an Ordinance. Part 1b to be deemed repealed on 1 October 1977.
